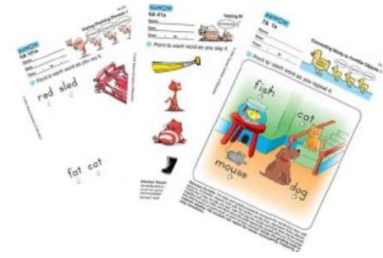


Kumon Reading Level 7A

Students begin building the pre-reading skills necessary to becoming emergent readers. Students connect words to familiar objects by pointing to and repeating words after hearing them read aloud.



When completing the Kumon worksheets at home, please follow these steps:

Do's	Don'ts
Write the name of your child, date and start time and end time on the 1 st page only.	Force your child to write their name, date and time.
Read the direction of the 1 st page aloud to your child.	Cover the picture and ask your child to guess or read the word.
Read the direction on the subsequent pages if necessary, to refocus your child.	Teach your child to sound out the word.
*Always read "Attention Parents" Notes on the 1 st page of every set. *	Use the worksheets to teach another language.
Begin immediately after writing the start time.	
Always read from left to right, top to bottom.	
Have your child point at the word, not the picture.	
If your child has difficulty with saying the words, model read the words again.	
If your child is not confident to repeat after you, use the "I say (parent), we say (together), you say (child)" rule.	
Praise your child when he/she has completed all the worksheets.	

*Attention Parents Notes: These notes contain information about the goal of each worksheet set, repeating rule ("I say, we say, you say") and grading direction. These notes are indicated on the "a" side of page 1, 11, 21, 31, 41, 51, 61, 71, 81, 91, 101, 111, 121, 131, 141, 151, 161, 171, 181, 191.

Other tips to supplement Kumon at Home:

- Ask your Instructor for Kumon's Recommended Reading List and Read Aloud List! Ask for books that your child can practice on his or her own with your help.
- Read aloud to your child with animation and expression.
- Read their favorite books over and over.
