

Kumon Math Level 4A

Students begin writing numbers up to 50 and deepen their understanding of number sequence through number reading and writing. By the end of this level, students learn to read up to 100.



When completing the Kumon worksheets at home, please follow these steps:

Do's	Don'ts
Write the name of your child, date and start time and end time on the 1st page only.	Force your child to write their name, date and time.
Read the direction of the 1st page only to your child.	Use the worksheets to teach another language.
Always read "Attention Parents" Notes on page 1a,31a, 41a,51a, 101 a-b.	Require your child to count each object or picture if they are able to say the total number without counting.
Begin immediately after writing the start time.	Overly emphasize neatness initially during the level, allow your child to become comfortable with work skills through practice of writing numbers.
Always work from left to right, top to bottom.	
Have your child point at the numbers, not the picture.	
If your child has difficulty with reading the numbers, model read the numbers and have your child read along with you.	
Praise your child when he/she has completed all the worksheets.	
Have your child read the numbers in a rhythmical manner while point at each one.	
Guide your child's hand as needed when tracing numbers.	

***Attention Parents Notes: The notes on page 1a,31a, 41a,51a, 101a-b contains reminders about reading the numbers in a rhythmical manner and number board practice.**

Other tips to supplement Kumon at Home:

- It is important to be involved in your child's learning by demonstrating how to read the numbers and reading along with them.
- Practice recognizing numbers in daily activity.
- Practice the magnetic number board while gradually increasing the number pieces.
