

Kumon Math Level 5A

Students are introduced to numbers up to 50 and continue to develop skills with counting and reciting numbers while becoming familiar with numbers up to 100.



When completing the Kumon worksheets at home, please follow these steps:

Do's	Don'ts
Write the name of your child, date and start time and end time on the 1 st page only.	Force your child to write their name, date and time.
Read the direction of the 1 st page only to your child.	Include the object name when counting.
Always read "Attention Parents" Notes on page 1a, 6a, 11a, 101b, 102b and 191a.	Use the worksheets to teach another language.
Begin immediately after writing the start time.	Require your child to count each object or picture if they are able to say the total number without counting.
Always work from left to right, top to bottom.	
Read the number while pointing to each one.	
If your child has difficulty with reading the numbers, model read the numbers and have your child read along with you.	
Your child may check the box if they can.	
Praise your child when he/she has completed all the worksheets.	
Have your child read the numbers in a rhythmical manner while pointing to each one.	

*Attention Parents Notes: The notes on page 1a, 6a, 11a, 101b, 102b and 191a contain tips on how to help your child how read the numbers as well as number board practice activity.

Other tips to supplement Kumon at Home:

- It is important to be involved in your child's learning by demonstrating how to read the numbers and reading along with them.
- Practice recognizing numbers in daily activity.
- Practice the magnetic number board while gradually increasing the number pieces.
