


## Kumon Reading Level 3A

Students master pre-reading skills by trying to decode words with various vowel combinations, two-syllable words with middle double consonants, and two syllable compound words.

When completing the Kumon worksheets at home, please follow these steps:



Do's	Don'ts
Let your child write their name, date, start time and end time on the 1 <sup>st</sup> page only.	Ask your child to say the focus sounds that are not the focus of the worksheet set.
Read the directions aloud to your child.	Cover the picture and ask your child to read the words.
*Always read "Attention Parents" Notes on the 1 <sup>st</sup> page of every set. *	Use the worksheets to teach another language.
Begin immediately after writing the start time.	Encourage your child to complete the worksheet without saying the focus sounds, words and sentences.
Make sure your child copies and writes the letters neatly with correct stroke order and the writing fits in the spaces given.	
Encourage your child to write the words all at once and not letter by letter.	
Always have your child say the focus sounds aloud as he or she traces the letters.	
Always have your child says words and sentences aloud.	
If your child doesn't know a word, help him/her sound out by pointing to the focus sounds that he/she can already sound out.	
Praise your child after he/she reads the words or sentences aloud.	
Praise your child when he/she has completed all the worksheets.	

\*Attention Parents Notes: The notes on the "a" side of page 1, 11, 21, 31, 41, 51, 61, 71, 81, 91 contain directions to help your child sound out the focus sounds and pronounce the word accurately, as well as pointing to each word in the direction to expose your child to new vocabulary.

Other tips to supplement Kumon at Home:

- Ask your Instructor for Kumon's Recommended Reading List and Read Aloud List! Ask for books that your child can practice on his or her own with your help.
- Read aloud your child with animation and expression.
- Read their favorite books over and over.
